He composed his first song entitled “Hang On In There” at the age of 13. After high school, he studied music under the tutelage of Professor Clark at Wayne State University. Derrick taught piano and voice at the Clark Conservatory School of Music, which was founded by Dr. Mattie Moss Clark. Derrick was ordained an Elder in the Church of God in Christ in August of 2000.

Derrick's gift has made room for him, allowing him to travel from Europe to Africa as Musical Director for the renowned Clark Sisters, Vanessa Bell Armstrong and tour with the late Min. Thomas A. “Maestro” Whitfield and the Whitfield Company. Derrick was featured in the Gospel Round Up Magazine as one of the Top Ten Songwriters in Gospel music today. His work has received numerous Grammy, Dove, and Stellar Award nominations. Derrick's smash hit “Take It Back” earned him the coveted 2010 BMI Songwriter of the Year Award. Derricks' name has become synonymous with writer, producer, musician, composer, arranger, musical consultant, worship leader, workshop facilitator, theatrical productions, and special events musical director.
