Ever think your prayers are bouncing off the ceiling and not reaching God's ear, if they even get as far as the ceiling? Ever think that the small offering of time, talent, finance, or your willingness to serve Him doesn't hold much weight in the Kingdom of God?

I want you to know that **YOU ARE** making a difference! Just this past week I saw a tsunami on Facebook, not realizing that this tsunami had just occurred in Indonesia. It wasn't until I saw the news I realized someone took pictures of it as it happened and put it on the Internet for all to see.
