

Gospel Tid-bits to Grow By . . .

- God's Kingdom was first revealed in the very beginning – back in the Garden of Eden with Adam and Eve.
- **God's plan** for His Kingdom **has not changed!**
- In God's Kingdom, we **live—every day-- above all** circumstances. Did He not say we are **seated** together with Christ Jesus in Heavenly Places?
- We find **righteousness, peace, and joy** in the Holy Ghost **as we dwell** in God's Kingdom.
- The Kingdom of Heaven and the Kingdom of God are terms that refer to the same thing where **God is the ultimate ruler, Jesus is the King of all kings, and the Holy Ghost is God's presence** that is **moving upon the earth**—and in us (the children of God)—today.
- **God's plan for you** was **established** a long time ago—**before you were born**; and God has **not** changed His mind about you!
- Every time you meet a **new challenge God strengthens you** by proving that He not only **supplies the tools you need**, but is **responsible for the outcome**.
- What you actually believe is revealed by what you do!
- **Obedience** to God **leads to blessings** so great that it will **touch the lives** of those **around you**.
- **God is in control** of any **circumstance you are facing**: Master **over** fear, Master **over** sickness, Master **over** weakness, Master **over** lack.
- Knowing you are **walking in God's will** enables you to **rise above** the **challenges** that come your way.
- **Impatience** or **acting independently** of God **will get you into trouble**. – Wait upon God! He will open the door at the appointed time.
- The **Holy Ghost knows** the mind of God. He will bring a **deep peace to your heart** as you **walk where God wants you to be**.
- When you are in **right standing with God**, all the **rest will fall into place**.
- As long as you **keep your eyes on God**, He can correct you, teach you, help you, and cause you to **grow stronger in faith**.
- God wants to bring us all to the place where **we no longer question the path or the price** as we operate in His will.
- God won't control your emotions, but neither will He let them influence Him.
- **God is patient**. He will work with you year after year in an attempt to bring you to the place of spiritual maturity where you can fulfill the purpose for which He brought you into His Kingdom; but **if you refuse** to produce fruit, **He will go elsewhere** to find a willing vessel. **In the end, God's purpose will be fulfilled – either with or without you**.
- Tackle your fears head-on! Whenever I am afraid, I will trust in you, God.
- **Prayer invites God into a situation and authorizes the forces of heaven** to go to work and bring change.
- **You are not the average person** – you are a new creation in Christ, led by His Spirit!
- **Pride** does not please God.
- When God wants to do something wonderful through you, He has to get you from where you are to where He is.
